What is a Chromebook?



A Chromebook is an affordable laptop designed for school and work.

Chromebooks are easy to use, easy to manage, and help to eliminate incompatibilities between operating systems. The Chromebook runs on Chrome OS which looks much like the Chrome Internet browser. It has built-in virus protection and a long lasting battery. A Chromebook will typically start up in less than 10 seconds.

Why Did We Choose Chromebooks?



Excellent battery life (10 hours)

Integrates perfectly with G-Suite (Google)

Quick to boot and resume (under 10 seconds from a cold start)

Can be used offline (some functionality)

Designed to be easy to manage and repair

Always up-to-date operating system/secure

Affordable

Perfect device for state testing

What Will Our Kids Do With Chromebooks?



Gain hands-on experience with latest collaboration and productivity tools

Sharpen organizational and time management skills (Google Drive)

Create presentations, research papers

Explore online curriculum (Google Classroom)

Take online assessments

Filtered Internet



Students will authenticate using their school-issued Google accounts before accessing the Internet

Devices and web content are filtered on and off-site according to CIPA (Child Internet Protection Act) requirements regardless of wifi connection or location

Filtering Policy



Students will have stricter web filtering policies applied during school hours

Students will have more open web filtering policies after school hours

If parents would like stricter web policy 24/7, that can be arranged

Protection Plan



Students will be expected to pay \$25.00 annually as part of Evergreen High School's 1:1 Protection Plan. This \$25.00 will be used for repairs and replacement costs associated with normal Chromebook usage. Protection Plan payments will be collected at Schedule Pick-Up Day (August 8, 2017).

Picking Up the Chromebook



Chromebooks will be picked up on Schedule Pick-Up Day (August 8, 2017).

All High School students will be issued the Chromebook at that time, and the Protection Plan payment must be made.

The Chromebook will come with a stay on protective case, mouse, ear buds and power pack.

Info For Parents



Students must follow AUP (Acceptable Use Policy). The AUP is available on our website and via this link. [AUP](#)

Devices are to be turned in at the end of the school year in good working condition and reissued the following school year.

Lost/Stolen/Damaged



Principals/Administrators must be notified of any lost or stolen device or accessory. An official police report must be filed. The Parent/Guardian/Student is responsible for the replacement cost.

Repairs caused by intentional abuse will be the responsibility of the Parent/Guardian/Student. The repair costs will be charged on a per incident basis. This will be broken down on the following slide

Chromebooks will be randomly checked for damage

Accidental Damage Payments



1st Offense - \$10.00

2nd Offense - \$25.00

3rd Offense - \$35.00

In the event of an accidental break or damage, students will be charged repair costs. Accidental damage is defined as: screen cracks, water damage, protective case damage, and battery pack/cord damage, etc. After the third occurrence you may potentially lose your device take-home privileges.

A damage report must be filed for every occurrence. The damage report will be available on our web site. A link to this form is available on this slide.

Can I bring my own device?



No, Students may not bring their own personally owned device.

- We have very carefully tested and selected devices that meet our requirements for:
 - Battery Life
 - Heat Tolerance
 - Noise Tolerance
 - Seamless Wifi Compatibility
 - Speed and RAM, so that we know all students can handle running the same amount of apps simultaneously for class projects.

Why can't I bring my own?



It is also much easier for teachers to teach knowing that everyone is using the same device, and helps minimize downtime due to quirks from untested devices

School issued chromebooks are managed for our students and have certain apps and policies pushed out by the district

They have all of the applications and security that is needed

Student Expectations



- Students should bring the Chromebook to school everyday fully charged
 - Chromebooks should be charged at home
- Chromebooks are to remain in the case at all times
- Students will use Chromebooks for school and educational purposes only
- Students will complete assigned online course work on the Chromebook.
- Students are not permitted to personalize any part of the Chromebook or accessories
- Students are expected to return the Chromebook in a clean, good working condition at the district's request
- Students will talk to parents/guardians before connecting the Chromebook to the internet at home or other locations

Student Expectations Cont.



- Do not remove any asset tags or labels
- Do not leave the Chromebook unattended
- Never lift or carry the Chromebook by the screen
- The Chromebook case should be securely closed whenever the device is carried
- Do not pick or pull at any of the keys or trackpad
 - If keys need to be replaced you may be without the Chromebook for a while
- Do not pull the Chromebook by the cord

Caring for the Chromebook



Clean the Chromebook regularly with a soft dry cloth (microfiber). Similar to what you would use on your phone or eyeglasses.

Never use any type of cleaner on the keyboard or screen.

The Chromebook should remain in the protective case at all times

Information for Students



The Chromebook that you are issued will follow you your entire high school career, so take care of it.
