The Evergreen Local School District was formed in 1964 with the merger of Fulton, Lyons, Metamora and Chesterfield districts in Fulton and Lucas counties. The district encompasses 128 square miles. Block Schedule:	The school day is divided into four 90-minute instructional periods. The class sessions are completed in one term. There are two terms each school year. Grading periods occur mid-term and at the completion of each term. An exam grade is also given at the end of the term.
