

EVERGREEN HIGH SCHOOL FOUR-YEAR EDUCATIONAL PLAN

2016-2017

The following courses are graduation requirements.
A total of 26 credits are required for students graduating from
Evergreen High School.

A total of 21 credits are required for students graduating from
Four County Career Center or a special education school.

LANGUAGE ARTS (4 credits required)

- **Language Arts 9**
- must be taken in grade 9
- **Language Arts 10 or Honors Language Arts 10**
- must be taken in grade 10
- **Language Arts 11 or Honors Language Arts 11**
- must be taken in grade 11
- **Language Arts 12 or Honors Language Arts 12**
- must be taken in grade 12

SOCIAL STUDIES (3 credits required)

- **World History**
- must be taken in grade 9
- **American History**
- must be taken in grade 10
- **American Government**
- must be taken in grade 11 (grade 12 for Four-County Students)

The State of Ohio requires that students complete a financial literacy lesson prior to graduation. Students at Evergreen will complete this lesson during Social Studies 10.

SCIENCE (3 credits required)

- **Physical Science** - must be taken in grade 9

Two more science courses are required, choose from:

- **Biology**
- **Biology II**
- **Chemistry (should be included if planning to attend college)**
- **Anatomy & Physiology**
- **Physics**

MATH (4 credits required and must include Algebra II)

- Algebra I Concepts* or Algebra I Applications (*Concepts does not meet NCAA requirements)**
- Geometry**
- Algebra II Concepts A* or Algebra II Applications (*Concepts does not meet NCAA requirements)**
- Algebra II Concepts B* (*Concepts does not meet NCAA requirements)**
- Algebra II Applications**
- Statistics**
- Senior Math**
- Pre-Calculus**
- Trigonometry**
- AP Calculus (counts as two credits)**

PE/HEALTH (1 credit required)

- PE/Health**
- should be taken in grade 9

COMPOSITE REQUIREMENT (1 credit required)

One credit required, choose from:

- Accounting**
- Integrated Applications**
- Any Art Class**
- Any Music Class**
- Speech**
- Any Foreign Language Class**
- Any Career Technical Class**
- Any Family and Consumer Science Class**
- Any Agriculture Class**
- Any Math Class above the required four**
- Any Social Studies elective**

The State of Ohio requires that students complete one year or one credit of fine art between grades 7-12 prior to graduation.

The remainder of the course work may be academic or non-academic electives and must total at least 26 credits prior to graduation (21 credits for Four County students and students who attend school at a different building).
